



The Kawānanakoa Band Booster Club is participating in the
2021 Give Aloha Foodland's Annual Community Matching Gifts Program

How It Works

From September 1-30, customers are invited to make donations of up to \$249 to participating Hawaii non-profit organizations at checkout. Donations are accepted at any Foodland, Sack N Save or Foodland Farms checkout. Foodland and the Western Union Foundation will match a portion of each donation. Individuals must use their own Maika'i number to make a donation. Donations made without a Maika'i number will not be matched.

How to Donate to the Kawānanakoa Band Booster Club:

1. Go to any Foodland, Sack N Save or Foodland Farms stores statewide.
2. At the cashier checkout or customer service counter, present your Maika'i Card and inform the cashier that you would like to make a donation (in the form of cash, check or credit card) to:

3. If you do not have a Maika'i card/number, you may request to establish one. Your donation will be added to your grocery purchase total. You may donate up to \$249 per organization; any portion exceeding \$249 will not be matched. The amount you donate and the name of our organization will appear on your receipt. Donations must be payable to Foodland or Sack N Save.
4. Donor names will not be released to the Kawānanakoa Band Booster Club. Please ask the cashier for a duplicate receipt and complete the attached form along with a copy or photo of the receipt showing your donation. Submit the form to Band Director Guy Lum with your child's name along with the donor's name and donation amount so a donation letter can be sent to you and your child can be credited for your efforts.
5. Donors must use their Maika'i Card to make a donation and can donate up to a cumulative total of \$249 per person.

Are These Contributions Tax Deductible?

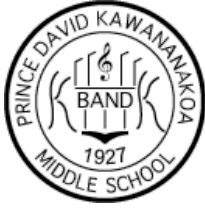
These contributions are tax deductible to the fullest extent of the law. Please save your store receipt for tax purposes since it will be the only record you will have of your donation(s).

How the Matching Gift Will be Calculated

Matching gifts will be determined at the end of the program. Our organization will receive 100% of all customer donations given to us, plus each donation made with a Maika'i card, will be partially matched by a gift from Foodland and the Western Union Foundation. Last year, the total amount collected for the *Give Aloha Program* was over \$600, in addition the Foodland and Western Union Foundation donated an additional \$140 to the Boosters. Opt Out of Fundraising Activities

If you would like to opt out of participating in fundraising activities for the school year (e.g. selling 7-Eleven books, Zippy's tickets, car wash, etc...), we kindly ask for a minimum \$100 donation per family that is tax deductible to the full extent of the law. We are encouraging families to make your donation through this *Give Aloha Program* as we will receive additional funds for your donation.
