
Rhythm Diagramming Instructions


Simplified

Step 1 - Place the beat number(s) under each note.


Be sure to place the number beneath the note that it belongs to.



Step 2 - If a note is more than one beat long, put the numbers AFTER the starting beat in parenthesis.



Step 3 - For rests, place ALL numbers belonging to that rest in parenthesis and write an "R" beneath.



Reminders:

- The last number of each measure needs to match the top number of the time signature. The time signature tells you exactly how many beats should be in each measure.
- When using parenthesis for long notes and rests, each symbol has its own set of parenthesis. Do not regroup long notes followed by rests or consecutive rests.
